A Proclamation

CHARLES THE THIRD, by the Grace of God, King of Canada and His other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth

To all to whom these presents shall come — Greeting

WHEREAS meaningful employment is significant to people with disabilities, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to upholding and safeguarding the principles outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, including full and effective participation and inclusion in society, and equitable opportunity, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to working with employers to recruit, retain and promote people with disabilities in their workplaces to stimulate economic growth and increase productivity throughout British Columbia, and

WHEREAS Disability Employment Month is an opportunity to celebrate and share the valuable contributions of people with disabilities and employers who demonstrate inclusion and leadership;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 2025 shall be known as

"Disability Employment Month"

in the Province of British Columbia.
